Registered means you tell us about your pet dog or cat.

More information

Every dog and cat must be registered after they are 3 months old.

All cats registered by Wodonga Council must be desexed.



Pet tag

When you register your dog or your cat the Wodonga Council will give you a tag.

You put this tag on the pet's collar.

The tag tells other people about your pet.

If your pet gets lost the tag will help other people to know where your pet lives.



Registration cost

You can ask the Wodonga Council how much it costs to register your pet.



You will need to pay the registration by April 10 every year.

The Wodonga Council will send you a letter to tell you it is time to pay.

Your registration costs less if your dog

• is more than 6 months old

and

• is desexed.

Microchip

Every dog and cat must have a microchip after they are 3 months old.



A microchip has information

- about the dog or cat
- about the owner.

A microchip has information about the owner of the dog or cat.

A vet puts the microchip in the dog or cat.




You must tell us if you change your

address



• phone number.



Rules

Cats must be kept in your property between 7pm and 7am.

You must be able to control your dog when you take it outside your property.



Your dog must

- do everything you tell it to do or
- be kept on a lead.

You must always pick up the poo from your dog or your cat when you take it outside your property.

You can **not** have more than 2 dogs or more than 2 cats on your property.
