

# CORPORATE FLU VACCINATIONS

## The flu season is fast approaching.

The typical work environment provides ideal conditions for the influenza virus to thrive, and will infect more than 23,000 Australians each year.

Wodonga Council has a mobile immunisation service which provides onsite vaccination to businesses across North East Victoria and Southern NSW.

Influenza can significantly impact your workplace, and costs businesses considerable amounts of money each year due to:

- Absenteeism, replacement and overtime costs;
- Interruption of service and/or product delivery; and,
- Lost or reduced sales and productivity.

Protect your staff with an annual flu vaccination this autumn, to reduce their chance of becoming ill.

## Things you might not know about the flu vaccine:

- There is no live virus in the flu vaccine;
- The composition of the vaccine changes every year and a new 4 strain (quadrivalent) flu vaccine is available this year; and,
- The flu vaccine is safe for pregnant women at all stages of their pregnancy.

## The council provides:

- The convenience of onsite vaccinations for workplaces with five or more staff;
- Reduced rate and flexibility for large organisations (50 or more vaccinations);
- Accredited and experienced vaccination nurses;
- All equipment and related medical supplies; and,
- A list of vaccinated staff with invoice.

**Pricing from \$22 per person (GST inclusive) or \$33 per person (GST inclusive) for the quadrivalent vaccine.**

Discounts may apply where 50 or more vaccinations are administered per visit.

## Seasonal flu vaccine composition:

- A (H1N1): an A/California/7/2009 (H1N1)pdm09-like virus;
- A (H3N2): an A/Hong Kong/4801/2014 (H3N2)-like virus;
- B: a B/Brisbane/60/2008-like virus;

Quadrivalent vaccines contain viruses listed above, plus the additional B virus:

- B: a B/Phuket/3073/2013-like virus.
