

# Sustainable Living Fair market stallholder terms and conditions

These terms and conditions apply to stallholders attending the Albury Wodonga Sustainable Living Fair (SLF).

- By providing your email address you are agreeing to receive information regarding the Fair electronically
- Stallholders must be aged 18 years and over
- Only goods and services approved by the SLF team are permitted for sale and display
- Approval from the SLF team is required for the addition of new product lines
- Sites are not to be sub-let by stallholders
- Joint stallholders are permitted subject to approval by the SLF team
- Public liability cover (minimum of \$10,000,000) is required for stallholders who sell or provide products that can be eaten, ingested or applied
- If selling food, stallholders must comply with the requirements of the *Food Act 1984* and the Food Standards Code (safe food handling practices, labelling etc.), and where applicable have a qualified Food Safety Supervisor
- For powered sites, leads must be current and tested and tagged by a certified provider
- All food vendor sites must bring a current stamped fire extinguisher suitable to your cooking requirements along with a fire blanket
- No provision is made for the parking of stallholder vehicles
- Stallholders are advised that, prior to any structures being built/erected, approval is to be granted by the SLF team
- Stallholders and vendors are responsible for providing and setting up their own equipment, for example; tables, marquees and umbrellas
- Stallholders must ensure that all stall equipment including structures, umbrellas, clothes racks and stock is adequately secured to prevent injury
- Stallholders must confine their goods within the boundaries of their sites and no merchandise is to protrude onto the footways or public areas
- Stallholders are to be in attendance at their allocated stall site by 9am on the day of the Fair
- Vehicles are not permitted onsite during Fair times, unless permitted by the SLF Team
- Spruiking and amplified noise is not permitted
- Stallholders are to make all reasonable endeavours to vacate their site no later than one hour after the official closing time of the Fair
- Sites shall be left clean by stall holders and waste generated from the stall is to be taken by the stallholder
- Site fees will not be refunded or transferred if you are unable to attend the Fair
- If the Fair is cancelled by the SLF team, a full refund will be issued to the stallholder applicant
